The FA's Code of Respect:**

- Have fun, it's what we're all here for !
- Always show respect for all players, opponents, managers/coaches and officials.
- Have realistic expectations for your son/daughter and do not put them under undue pressure.
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- Demonstrate a supportive behaviour to the players, when players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time.
- Never engage in, or tolerate insulting, offensive or abusive language or behaviour
- Leave Coaching to the Coaches.
- Respect the Managers/Coaches Decisions.
- Stay behind the touchline and within the designated (Respect) areas where provided
- Feel free to raise any concerns or issues you may have with the coach or club official
- Assist when asked.
- Accept disappointment, praise good work and refrain from criticising.
- Emphasise skill development and practice over winning

I understand that if I do not follow the code I may be :

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet the Club, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Obligated to take undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend training or future games,
- Required to leave the club
